Our second event is new this year and adds to our established holiday celebrations. **The Soulball** will take place at the Buffalo Transportation Pierce Arrow Museum from 5:30 PM – 8:00 PM. The holiday party will invite attendees to enjoy music, hors d'oeuvres, wine & beer, basket raffle, visits from Kente Claus, historic stories from the Corridor, and holiday cheer.

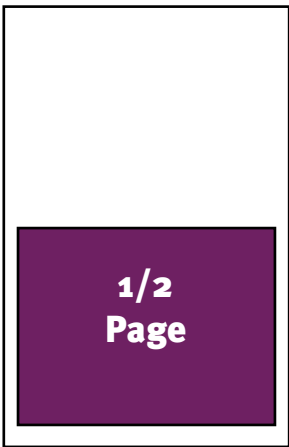

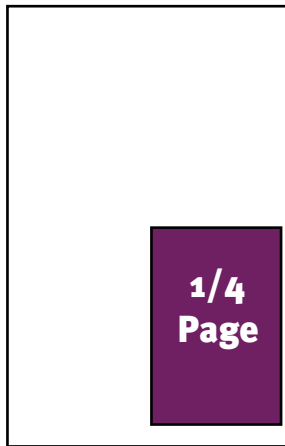

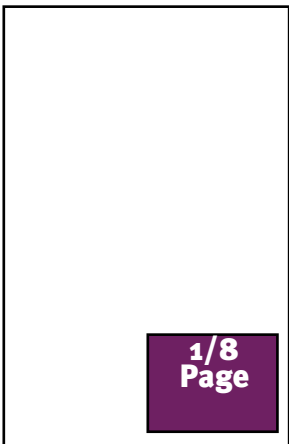
